# HEADTEACHERS AWARD

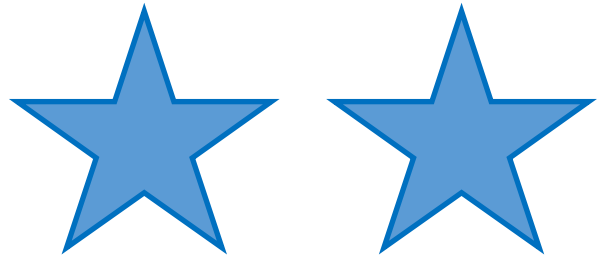
This week as well as celebrating Star of the Week we gave out some very special Headteacher Awards.
